- § To add a Wharton graduate-level course, non-MBA students must complete and submit a Registration Authorization Form to the MBA Program Office (JMHH 300) by the last day that MBA students are permitted to enroll in the requested course per the Academic Calendar. Petitions may be considered after that date and honored based on availability.
