All International Students:

- Aga Khan Foundation: The Aga Khan Foundation provides a limited number of scholarships each year for postgraduate studies to outstanding students from developing countries who have no other means of financing their studies. - American Scandinavian Foundation: The ASF's award program for study and research abroad has been the Foundation's most long-standing commitment. - **The Margaret McNamara Memorial Fund:** Established in 1981 to honor the late Margaret McNamara and her commitment to the well-being of women and children in developing countries. - The Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowships for New America: The Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowship for New Americans program honors the contributions of immigrants to the United States. <u>http://pdsoros.org/</u>
- **P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship:** Provides international women with scholarships of up to \$10,000. US and Canadian citizens or permanent residents are not eligible. Applicants must be enrolled in a graduate program in the US or Canada and must promise to return to their home country to pursue their career. The application packet is due by January 31of the year for which the scholarship is requested.

Since 1989, its chairman is Isidore Alvarez, the current chairman of El Corte Ingles. The foundation sponsors scholarship program for studies abroad to enable

The General Sir John Monash Award is a prize of AUD \$50,000 for academic excellence and demonstrated leadership and potential.
