

- Typically visit start-ups, big tech, VC funds (varies based on cohort interest)




SSF Fall 2017: Internship Breakdown by Industry N = 69





- Note: There is no dedicated incubation space available at Wharton San Francisco

Application Process

Application Process

Spring 2019:

- Applications open: September 5, 2018
- Applications due: October 5, 2018
- Decisions released: October 19, 2018
- Accept/decline by: November 9, 2018

Round 1, Fall 2019:

- Applications open: December 3, 2018
- Applications due: January 14, 2019
- Decisions released: February 8, 2019
- Accept/decline by: March 15, 2019
- No waitlist: if not accepted in Round 1, you <u>can</u> apply again in Round 2!

Application Process

What do we look for?

- Strong academic performance GPA matters!
- Thoughtful, well written essays
 - > Focus on community, career, and academics
- No academic probation or ethics violations at any point in time

Logistics

Cost

- Program fee of \$5,000 per student
- Merit-based fellowships available (i.e., academic performance)

Housing

- Participants responsible for transportation & housing
- Opportunities to sublet Philadelphia apartments
 - MBAPO International Exchange
 - Coordination between Fall & Spring semester students
