#### **Budget**

Students will have a base budget of 5000 tokens for Fall 2023. If you complete the MBA Stakeholder Survey, you will receive a bonus of 500 tokens for both fall and spring Course Match (a total of 5500 tokens each term). The bonus tokens will be added to your account soon.

# Holds

Students who are on hold will not be able to participate in Fall 2023 Course Match until the hold has been resolved. Once holds have been lifted, access to Course Match will be reinstated. ### **Course Match Updates**

We have upgraded the Course Match platform with an improved interface and mobile-friendly design. You will notice some changes when you access the system. Nothing has changed about how Course Match works - you will continue to add utilities and manage courses just as you had before.

Here are few notable layout and interface changes:

- Along the top of every page is an easy way to navigate across My Course Match, My Utilities, and My Top Schedules.
- The "My Course Match" page presents some information that was in a sidebar on the former site. From this page you can:
  - Update the maximum amount of Course Units you want Course Match to assign
  - Review your budget
  - See your current enrollment for the term
  - View a graphic representation of your course schedule
  - See the status of your graduation requirements
- On the "My Utilities" page, a comprehensive filter will allow you to quickly find the courses you are looking for. Previously, options to view distributions and manage adjustments were in a sidebar – these now have their own sections among which you can toggle via tabs.
- On the new "My Top Schedules" page, you can generate potential schedules based on your utilities in a cleaner layout

# Prerequisite for REAL 8210

Enrollment in REAL 8210 (Real Estate Development) requires the prerequisite REAL 7210/FNCE 7210: Real Estate Investments. Only students who have completed REAL 7210/FNCE 7210 will be permitted to place utilities on REAL 8210. If you choose to take the requisite REAL 7210/FNCE 7210 concurrently with REAL 8210, you must contact your academic advisor by Friday, August 18th to have REAL 8210 "unlocked" in Course Match.

Registration will be verified by the add/drop deadline; students not meeting the requisite requirement will be dropped from REAL 8210.
